

Frederick Hoffmann, 74

Panama — Frederick Hoffmann, son of Anton and Mary Wingert Hoffmann was born Dec. 16, 1905 on a farm near Panama. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary's church, Panama. He attended school at St. Mary's school.

On Feb. 11, 1930, he married Patricia Buckley at St. Mary's church in Panama. Six children were born to this union. After their marriage, they farmed near Panama. He continued to farm after the death of Mrs Hoffmann on July 21, 1961. Mr Hoffmann was a member of St. Mary's church, Panama. He died at his home on Saturday, Sept. 27, 1980, at age 74 years, nine months and 11 days.
