Holmes, 16, died of a gunshot wound from a .22 rifle suffered Wednesday at his home at 806 Market St., Harlan.

Investigators said the wound was apparently self-inflicted. Shelby County Medical

Examiner Dr. R. D. Harris estimated the shooting occurred between 10 and 10:30 a.m. The body was discovered by the boy's stepfather, David Horney, in the youth's bedroom at approximately 1:30 p.m.

Holmes was born in Harlan, attended kindergarten at Newton, Ia., and resided in the Avoca area from 1974-'80 before moving with his family to Harlan. He was a Harlan Community High School

sophomore. Surviving are his mother and stepfather, Mr. and Mrs. David Horney of Harlan; father, Richard Holmes of Cypress, Calif.; two brothers — Raymond Holmes, Creston, and Richard Lee Holmes, Shelby; two sisters - Sandy Holmes, Spencer, and Kathy Holmes, Rock Valley, Ia.; and maternal grandmother, Mrs. Hilda
