

Aurthur Hopp, 73

Arthur Albert Hopp, son of Ella Mass and Frank H. Hopp was born Jan. 27, 1909, at Treynor. He died Wednesday, March 10, 1982, at the St. Joseph hospital, Omaha at the age of 73 years.

He was educated in the Minden schools. On Jan. 26, 1930, he married Jennie Ogesen at Neola and to this union two sons were born. They farmed in the Minden area until 1935, when they moved to Harlan and operated a milk route and sold bulk milk for 30 years.

In 1953, he started the Hopp Construction Co. He was a member of the Harlan United Church of Christ. His outside interests centered around his love for his family and he enjoyed keeping up with his great grandchildren. He could never retire from the construction business he loved. He faithfully followed the girls basketball team and auto racing.

He was preceded in death by his father. Survivors include his wife, Jennie of Harlan, two sons; Donald and his wife Carol of Harlan and Franklin and his wife Sylvia of Millard, Neb.; his mother, Mrs Ella Rain and one sister, Mrs Hazel Kaven, both of Avoca. He is also survived by four grandchildren; five great grandchildren; and by other relatives.

Funeral services were held Saturday, March 13, 1982, at the Burmeister Funeral Home with Dr. Larry LaVelle officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Verle Doonan, Arthur Meyer, Richard Pauley, Gerald Wilson, Leland Kaltoft and Richard Andersen serving as casketbearers.
