Panama — Henry Peter Huebert, son of Henry and Elizabeth Henner Huebert Sr. was born Sept. 6, 1904, on a farm near Panama. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary's church in Panama and attended school at St. Mary's school, growing to adulthood on his parent's farm.

On May 11, 1931, he married Gertrude Leinen in St. Mary's church, Portsmouth. Six children were born to this union. After their marriage, they farmed the same farm, where Henry had grown to adulthood and where they have resided ever since. He was a member of St. Mary's church in Panama. He died at
