Glenn Hughes, 69

Glenn E. Hughes, son of James and Anna Schenk Hughes was born Sept. 13, 1915 at Portsmouth. He attended Portsmouth country schools and Portsmouth Catholic school.

He married Bernadine Gessert July 29, 1941 at St. Mary's church in Portsmouth. 13 children were born to this union. They farmed at Portsmouth until moving to Westfield in 1949. They farmed there until 1963 when they moved to Alcester, S.D. They farmed near Alcester until retiring to Akron in 1975.

He died at his home in Akron Saturday, Aug. 3, 1985 at age 69 years, 10 months, 21 days.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Bernadine in 1984, three sons, Richard, Samuel and William at birth; and one brother, Clair.
