

Ella G. Hulsebus, 82

Ella Georgia Hulsebus, daughter of Gerd and Antje Dian Janssen Husman was born Feb. 22, 1900 near Humphrey, Neb. She grew to adulthood helping on the family farm.

On Dec. 14, 1917, Ella married Sidney A. Hulsebus at the family home near Humphrey. Five children were born to this union. After their marriage, they lived in Nebraska for two years before moving to a farm near Defiance. In 1923, they moved into Defiance and this was their home until 1951, when they moved to Council Bluffs. After Mr Hulsebus passed away on July 20, 1955, Mrs Hulsebus continued to make her home in Co. Bluffs. In 1972, she moved to the Regal Towers in Co. Bluffs and this was her home until Aug. of this past year, when she became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan.

Mrs Hulsebus was a member of the Salem Evangelical United Brethren church in Defiance where she sang and played the piano. She was a member of the Eastern Star, Irwin Chapter No. 182 O.E.F. Later, she became a member of the Salem United Methodist church in Co. Bluffs. She died in Harlan on Oct. 13, 1982, having attained the age of 82 years.

In addition to her parents and husband, Ella was preceded in death by six brothers, one in infancy, Harm, and Ed, Fred, Henry, John and George Husmann and two sisters, one in infancy, Else and Minnie Brunken.

She is survived by four sons, Oliver of Omaha, Stan and Edgar, both of Co. Bluffs

and Douglas of Algona; one daughter, Bernice (Mrs Walter) Krantz of Harlan; nine grandchildren and nine great grandchildren; two sisters, Anna (Mrs Phillip) Prang and Lydia Husmann, both of Columbus, Neb.; nieces and nephews; other relatives and many friends.

Funeral services was held at the Salem United Methodist church in Co. Bluffs on Saturday, Oct. 16, 1982 with Pastor Laurice Streyffeler officiating.
