PERSIA — Services for a Persia man, Russell C. Ickes, 54, will be Wednesday at 1:30 p.m. in the Persia RLDS Church, with burial in Shelby Cemetery.

He was a member of the V.F.W., American Legion and the Royal Order of the Moose. He died Saturday, Oct. 8, 1977 at University of Nebraska hospital, Omaha, after a lengthy illness at age 54 years.
