Clara A. Jensen, 70

Elk Horn - Clara Augusta Jensen was born in Denmark on Aug. 12, 1908, daughter of Niels and Johana Winther Nielsen. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. Clara came to the U.S. at age 5 with her family. They settled north of Kimballton where she attended rural school. Later they moved to Coon Rapids, where she completed education.

On Feb. 27, 1944 she married Lorens Jensen. They lived in Elk Horn until 1960 when they moved to their present farm home east of Elk Horn. She became a U.S. citizen on April 23, 1963. She was a member of the EIK Horn Lutheran church. She died Tuesday, April 17, 1979 at the Audubon County

hospital, at age 70 years.

She was preceded in death by two sisters and a brother. Sur-vivors include her husband; one son - John at home, four brothers Norman Nielsen of Exira, Otto Nelsen of Phoenix, Ariz., Marvin Nielsen of Sioux City and Paul Nelsen of Omaha, Neb., and a sister - Pauline Ploughman of Kimballton.

Funeral services were held Friday, April 20, 1979 at the Elk Horn Lutheran church with Pastor Eugene Soland, of-ficiating. Burial was in the Elk Horn cemetery with Leon Hoegh, Charles Mortensen, Albert Andersen, Chris Bladt, Emmert Andersen and Leon Christoffersen serving as casketbearers.
