

# Clifford K. Jensen, 80

Clifford Klitgaard Jensen, the son of Peter A. and Nikoline Fredricksen Jensen, was born in Broust, Denmark on April 29, 1899. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith in Denmark.

He attended school and grew to adulthood in Denmark. After graduating from high school he attended an university in Denmark. In 1920, he came to the United States and made his home with the Pete Petersen family at Jacksonville. Clifford attended Dana College at Blair, Nebr., and after completing his schooling, farmed near Irwin until retiring in 1969 and moving to Harlan. This has been his home since that time.

Mr Jensen died at the Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan, Oct. 12, 1979, having attained the age of 80 years, five months and 13 days. He had been a student of the Bible all his life.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother, Fred Jensen; and a sister, Andrea Gravesen. He is survived by a sister, Anna Pedersen of Everett, Wash., three step-sisters; nieces and nephews; other relatives and friends.

Funeral services were held at the Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan, Monday, Oct. 15, 1979, with Pastor Clifford H. Nelson of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Harlan officiating.

Burial was in the Harlan Cemetery, Harlan, with Dusty Field, Emory Hansen, Woodrow Hansen, Walter Knudsen, Anton Petersen and Harley Petersen serving as casketbearers.
