

THE LIFE STORY OF —

ELVY JENSEN, 83

Elvy Jensen, daughter of William and Mary Christiansen Jensen, was born in Harlan on Oct. 5, 1892. She attended school in Shelby county. Later the family moved to Manilla for several years. In 1915 they moved to Harrison county, Cass twp. Since 1947, she and her brother Arnel resided together on their farm in Cass twp. and later moved to Logan where she lived until the time of her death. She was a member of the Logan Christian church. She died at the Westmont Care Center, Logan on May 2, 1976 at age 83 years.

She was preceded in death by her parents and one sister - Mrs Myrtle Sunderland of Harlan. Survivors include five brothers - Arnel and Ernest Jensen of Logan, Grant and William Jensen of Harlan and Raymond Jensen of Missouri Valley and one sister, Mrs Hattie Divine of Marshalltown.

Funeral services were held May 4, 1976 at the Christian church in Logan with Robert H. Evans officiating. Burial was in Astor cemetery, Manilla with
