



Ilo R. Jensen, 77

Irwin — Ilo Rose Jensen, daughter of John P. and Elizabeth J. Watkins Mulligan, was born on a farm in Shelby county near Shelby, on Dec. 3, 1901. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary's church in Portsmouth. She attended school at Tennant, graduating from the Tennant high school and grew to adulthood on her parent's farm.

On Feb. 18, 1925, she married Anton C. Jensen in Harlan. Three daughters were born to this union. After their marriage, they farmed near Irwin. After Anton's death in 1950, Ilo moved to Harlan and this has been her home since that time. Mrs Jensen died at Jennie Edmundson Memorial hospital in Co. Bluffs, on Sunday, Sept. 23, 1979, at age 77 years, 9 months and 20 days. Ilo was a long time member of St. Michael's church and St. Ann's Guild in Harlan.

In addition to her parents and her husband, she was preceded in death by a brother, Sheridan Mulligan and a grandson, Frederick Sondag. Survivors include her daughters - Lois (Mrs Carl Rasmussen) and Rose (Mrs John Sondag), both of Irwin and Mary (Mrs Jerome Rauterkus) of Manilla; 14 grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren, by two brothers - John E. Mulligan of Denison and Hugh T. Mulligan of Defiance; nieces and nephews and other relatives.

A Concelebrated Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated at St. Michael's church in Harlan, on Wednesday, Sept. 26, 1979, with Rev. Richard G. Wagner as celebrant and Msgr. John McIlhon as concelebrant. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery, with Tony Sondag, Patrick Sondag, Peter Rasmussen, Samuel Rauterkus, Richard Rauterkus and Carl Rasmussen, Jr., all grandsons of Mrs Jensen, serving as pallbearers.
