

MRS. INGER JENSEN

Inger Margaret Jensen, the daughter of Englebrecht and Anna (Smidt) Petersen, was born in Ribe, Denmark, on October 8, 1889.

She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran Church.

She attended school and grew to adulthood in Denmark. After coming to the United States, Inger made her home in Shelby County, Iowa.

On April 10, 1912, she was united in marriage to Martin J. Jensen at his family home in Jackson Township.

After their marriage, Mr. and Mrs. Jensen made their home on a farm near Jacksonville until 1945 when they moved to Harlan. After Martin's death in August of 1962, Inger continued to make her home in Harlan. She became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home in the fall of 1973 and this has been her home since that time.

It was here that she died on April 29, 1979, having attained the age of 89 years, 6 months and 21 days.

Mrs. Jensen had been a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church and ILCW in Harlan.

In addition to her parents and her husband, she was preceded in death by two brothers, Peter and Hans Petersen; and by a sister, Elise Kargaard.

She is survived by nieces and nephews; other relatives and friends.
