

Mary E. Jensen, 76

Harlan — Mary Evangeline Jensen, daughter of Frank and Nettie Link Hazard, was born on a farm near Lewis, on April 29, 1904. She was baptized in the Methodist church and attended a country school. Since the age of 14, Mrs Jensen was on her own, working as a housekeeper.

On Aug. 2, 1924, she married Homer O.A. Jensen in Co. Bluffs. Four children were born to this union. They lived in Elk Horn, following their marriage and in 1930 they moved to Harlan where they have made their home since that time. Following Mr Jensen's death in 1972, Mrs Jensen continued to make her home at 506 Hill St., Harlan. She died at Jennie Edmundson hospital, Co. Bluffs on Friday, June 6, 1980 at age 76 years, one month and seven days.

In addition to her parents and her husband, she was preceded in death by four brothers - Franklin, Harry, Sam and Porter; and four sisters - Hazel, Hattie, Melva and Ellen. Survivors include three daughters - Evelyn (Mrs Lowell) Frampton of Kimballton, Elinor (Mrs Rae) Murray of Irwin, and Frances (Mrs Elmer C.) Jensen of Shelby; one son - Ronald K. Jensen of Denison; 17 grandchildren; 17 great-grandchildren; four step-great-grandchildren and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan, on Monday, June 9, 1980, with Mark W. Jervis, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery, with Rich Jensen, Jerri South, Brian Murray, James Frampton, James L. Nelson, and Clifford DeSchamp Jr. serving as casketbearers.
