Johannes, son of John and Minnie Hell Musfeldt, was born April 28, 1903 in Crawford county. He attended the rural schools in Washington twp., Carroll county and he married Lydia Asmus on Feb. 3, 1927. They farmed in the Manning area until moving to town in 1962. Herman died suddenly at his home Saturday afternoon, March 18, 1978 at age 74 years, 10 months and 20 days. Herman was a member of the Zion Lutheran church in Manning and in the past had served as an elder of the church.

He was preceded in death by his parents and by one brother, John Musfeldt. Survivors include his wife - Lydia and by one daughter - Ruth, (Mrs Don) Younie of Yankton, So. Dak., by three sons - David of Arcadia, Tom of Manilla and Sam of Audubon; 14 grandchildren; four great grandchildren and three brothers and two sisters - Albert of Manning; Ed of Omaha, Robert of Sarasota, Fla., Mrs Malinda Johansen of Harlan and Mrs Elda Gaskill of Audubon.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, March 21, 1978 in the Zion Lutheran church in Manning with Pastor Edward F. Heinicke, officiating. Burial was in the Manning cemetery with his grandsons serving as casket-bearers.
