## Gerald "Jerry" Johnson, 81

Gerald Maynard, son of Elmer and Christina Christinsen Johnson, was born June 16, 1904, in Kirkman. He attended the Kirkman and Harlan schools. On Sept. 8, 1929, he married Esther Marie Olsen.
