Violet was raised and educated in the Jacksonville area and was a rural school teacher for nine years until she married Walter Juhl on March 20, 1929 in Harlan. To this union three children were born; Merlin of Austin, Tex., Eugene of Irwin and Mary Ann (Mrs Oseas Barnedo) of Loma Linda, Calif. Violet and Walter have farmed for over 48 years east of Irwin, and are members of the Harlan Seventh Day Adventist church.
