Irwin — Walter S. Juhl, son of Anna Marie Sorensen and Lewis Juhl was born Aug. 24, 1899, in Center twp., Shelby county. He died Tuesday, Jan. 6, 1981, at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan at age 81 years, 4 months and 12 days.

He was educated in the Center twp. rural schools. In 1910 his family moved to Polk twp. He married Violet M. Paulsen on March 20, 1929 in Harlan. This union was blessed with three children. He has farmed and lived in Polk twp. for the past 70 years. He was an active member of the Harlan Seventh Day Adventist church.

Mr Juhl was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, Violet in 1977, three brothers: John, Harry and Alfred and one sister, Mrs Clara Petersen. Survivors include two sons, Merlin of Austin, TX. and Eugene of Irwin; one daughter - Mrs Mary Ann Barnedo of Los Angeles, Calif.; two brothers - Clarence of Irwin and Lester of Bellevue, Neb. and one sister - Mrs Anna Sorensen of Audubon; by eight grandchildren, nieces, nephews and other relatives.
