ELK HORN — Rose Justesen, daughter of August and Hulda Hitts Dittman, was born April 4, 1899 in Shelby. On Mar. 30, 1922 she married Ole Hans Justesen in Atlantic. This union was blessed with one daughter. The couple farmed in Shelby and Cass counties until retiring in 1964, when they moved to Atlantic. Mrs Justesen died at Cass County Memorial hospital in Atlantic on July 19, 1974 at age 75 years, 3 months, 15 days.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Ole, her parents, three brothers, two sisters. Survivors include her daughter - Mrs Kurt (Margie) Knoll of Omaha; a grandson - Lance Knoll of Omaha; a brother - John Dittman; and two sisters.
