

# George Kelley

George Frederick Kelley, son of William W. and Etta Weatherill Kelley, was born Aug. 20, 1898, in Harrison county. He died Nov. 14, 1976 at Myrtue Memorial hospital at age 78 years, 2 months and 24 days. George was educated in the rural Shelby county schools. He married Ida Rose on May 31, 1922, at Ainsworth, Nebr.; to this union three children were born. He has lived on farms in Shelby county all but six months of his life.
