

Enoch W. Lanphere, 80

Harlan — Enoch W. Lanphere was born Sept. 7, 1892 in Viroqua, Wisc. He died July 3, 1978 at the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha at age 85 years, 9 months and 26 days. As a young man he sailed on the Great Lakes until he entered WW I. He married Ethel Olson on Jan. 3, 1928 in Worthington, Minn. He worked as a mechanic for Booth Motors until WW II when he worked in the shipyards of Seattle, Wash. In 1960 he retired from the railroad.

He was preceded in death by his parents, brothers and sisters. Survivors include his wife Ethel of Harlan, one daughter Katheryn Miller of San Diego, Calif., one grandson-Craig Miller of Los Angeles, Cal., and two great granddaughters and other relatives.
