Kimballton — Walter Larsen was born Sept. 10, 1899 1½ miles north of Kimballton. He was one of eight children born to Andrew and Inger Mortensen Larsen. He was a confirmed member of the Bethany Lutheran church near Kimballton.

On Sept. 7, 1929 Walter and Edna Christensen were married in the Presbyterian Parsonage in Audubon. He farmed with his brother, Lauritz, until he was married, and then he moved 2¼ miles north of Kimballton. He and his wife, lived and farmed there until 1964 when she died. He then moved to Kimballton where he has worked for Arnold Christensen in the tavern until one month before his death.

He died Tuesday, Nov. 10, 1981 at the Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan at the age 82 years.

He is survived by three sisters: Anna (Mrs George) Jorgensen of Kimballton, Dagmar (Mrs Lawrence) Christensen of Hamlin, and Hannah (Mrs Marius) Christensen of Audubon. He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, Edna, three sisters, and one brother, Lauritz, who died only one week ago.

Funeral services were held Friday, Nov. 13, 1981 in the Koltoft Funeral Home in Kimballton with Pastor Douglas Kahl officiating.

Burial was in the Bethany Lutheran cemetery near Kimballton with Lynn Larsen, Harold Nielsen, Dean Christensen, Virgil Jensen, Verner Petersen and Donald Wiges serving as casketbearers.
