

## Carl Lorenzen, 81

Carl Fred Lorenzen, son of Peter and Josephine Scheel Lorenzen, was born in Shelby co., July 12, 1902 and received his education there.

He married Juanita Dreyer of Walnut on Jan. 2, 1924 at Harlan and they farmed for a while. He was an equipment operator for Pottawattamie co. for many years and following retirement from the county, he was caretaker of the Walnut cemetery for a number of years.

In Jan., 1979 they moved to Peace Haven. He was taken ill March 9, 1983 and died that morning at Cass county Memorial hospital at the age of 81 years.
