Irwin — Mrs. Victoria Mae Marks, daughter of Katie Petersen and Jens C. Hansen was born Oct. 15, 1895, in Harlan. She died Monday, Jan. 26, 1981, at Shady Oaks Care Center in Lake City, at age 85 years, 3 months and 11 days. She attended rural school in the Red Line area. She moved to Calif., in the 1930's and did house work for many years.

On Sept. 30, 1941, she married Joseph F. Marks in Reno, Nev. They lived in Oakland, Calif., until 1967, then they moved to Harlan to retire. She has been a resident of the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn for the past six years and has resided at Shady Oaks Care Center for the past five months. She was baptized at the Merrills Grove Baptist church on Oct. 15, 1921.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband Joseph in 1974, a brother George and one sister in infancy. Survivors include two brothers; Lewis Hansen of Denison and Nels Hansen of Irwin, three sisters; Mrs. Sophia Petersen of Kirkman, Mrs. Mable M. Carlson of Audubon and Miss Laura E. Hansen of Irwin, by nieces, nephews, and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, Jan. 28, 1981, at Burmeister Funeral Home in Harlan with Pastor Herbert K. Johnson of Platt, S.D., officiating.
