Harlan — Michael Marion Martin, son of Marion and Lotus Meier Martin, was born Sept. 19, 1954 in Harlan. He attended the Harlan Community schools, graduation from high school in 1975. While in high school, Mike worked for Martin Electric and continued to do so after his graduation.

On Aug. 29, 1975, he married Karla Kramer at St. Mary's Catholic church in Portsmouth. Two children were born to this union.

After their marriage, they made their home in Harlan where Mike continued to work for Martin Electric until becoming ill in Dec. of 1980. Most of his time during his illness was spent in the Bishop Clarkson Memorial hospital in Omaha. He was the first patient in the new Hematology Ward in Jan. of this year. He died at Myrtle Memorial hospital in Harlan on Friday, Sept. 18, 1981, one day before celebrating his 27th birthday.

He was preceded in death by his paternal grandparents, Francis Martins, and also his maternal grandfather, Mr Fred Meier.

Survivors include his wife, Karla of Harlan; their two sons, Maxwell and Carl, both at home; his parents, Marion and Lotus Martin of Harlan; one brother, Rick of Harlan; his maternal grandmother, Edna Meier of Persia; many aunts, uncles, cousins and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan on Monday, Sept. 21, 1981 with Dr. Larry LaVelle, pastor of the United Methodist church in Harlan, officiating.

Burial was in Harlan cemetery with Mark Rold, Tim Klein, Ralph Kramer, Tom Garrison, Kim Christensen and Mark M. Martin serving as casketbearers.
