Wilbur Allen McCoy, 68

Wilbur A. McCoy, son of Oren B. and Hattie Elizabeth Greg McCoy, was born June 14, 1915 at Persia and was raised in the Harlan area attending the Harlan schools.

He married Vivian Iona Sorensen on Sept. 29, 1937 at Logan. They lived at Harlan, Bellevue, Neb., Atlantic, Anita and Wiota. He was a farm hand and truck driver most of his life until retiring in 1976.
