Daisy M. McIntosh, daughter of Mary and Charles Claessens was born Jan. 10, 1888 at Creighton, Neb. Her family moved to Nevis, Minn. when she was three and here she was raised and educated.

On Jan. 22, 1908, she married George Glenn McIntosh and they moved to Irwin where Glenn was a telegraph operator for the railroad. In 1922, the family moved to Odebolt, and in 1927 they moved to Minneapolis, Minn., where they lived until going to Maple Manor Retirement Home in Anoka, Minn. in 1977.

Due to an early death of a daughter, she raised two grandsons, Don and Jim Johnson. She has resided in the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn for the past three years. She was a baptized member of the United Methodist church and a 50-year member of the Order of the Eastern Star. She died Saturday, Dec. 17, 1983 at the age of 95 years.
