

# Michael McMahon

Manilla — Michael Emmett McMahon, son of John and Johanna Collins McMahon, was born Sept. 28, 1893 near Manilla. He married Christina Agnes Peters on Nov. 7, 1914. He was an engineer for the Chicago North Western Railroad and later worked for the Milwaukee Railroad in Minneapolis.
