Vivian Mickelson, daughter of Parimous and Rozzie Hon Gaer was born April 29, 1908, on a farm in Redline Community. She attended school in the Redline area and also became a member of the Redline Church of Christ during her youth. After school Vivian taught school in both Jackson and Polk twp.

She married Normal Mickelson and one daughter was born to this union. After marriage they lived and farmed in the Irwin area. At the age of 31, her health failed her and after that time was confined to hospitals and nursing homes.

She was a member of the Redline Church of Christ. She died at the Stratford Care Center in Stratford on Saturday, April 16, 1983, at the age of 74 years, 11 months and 18 days.
