

# Accident fatal to Harlanite, 29

NORFOLK, NEBR. — John Miles, a 1968 graduate of Harlan Community High School, was fatally injured Wednesday in a construction-related accident south of here.

The Nebraska State Patrol said the Harlan native was killed when he was run over by

a loaded dump truck which was backing up. The truck was driven by Harlan Urban, 44, of O'Neill, Nebr.

The accident occurred at a construction site on U.S. Highway 81 seven miles south of Norfolk.

Miles had worked for Western Engineering of Harlan for the past six years.

Miles was dead at the scene, the patrol said.
