

# Harold Morris, 75

**Montana** — Harold White Morris, son of E. Frank and Nellie Morris was born March 24, 1905 in Shelby county. He attended Grinnell College for his undergraduate work, received a masters degree from the University of Montana and a doctorate from Oregon State Univ. He did post doctorate work at Stanford Univ.

He married Clare Gordon in Washington, Ia., on Dec. 28, 1946. They lived in Bozeman from 1949-53, then moved to Portland. After his retirement they returned to Bozeman.

He was a member and chaplain of Masonic Lodge No. 6, the Livingston Scottish Rite, York Rites and Albedoo Shrine and Gallatin Shrine. He served on the board of directors of the DeMolay, Bozeman Rotary club, Phi Delta Kappa (educational honorary) and the local, state and national chapters of the Retired Teachers Assn. He was a veteran of WWII and a member of the Presbyterian church. He died Wednesday, Jan. 7, 1981 at his home at age 75 years.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Elliott. Survivors include his wife, Clare, a brother, Robert F. Morris of Crawford, Neb., three nephews, two nieces, and two foster daughters, Mrs Lawrence (Cleo) Loobey of Sturgis, So. Dak., and Mrs Blair (Valerie) Acker of Prineville, Oreg.

Funeral services were held Monday, Jan. 12, 1981 at Dokken-Nelson Sunday Chapel. Burial was in Sunset Hills cemetery.
