

Peter Moser 91, Is Dead

Funeral services were held last Monday for Peter Moser, 91, at Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic church with Father Sylvester Grady officiating.

Burial was in the Holstein cemetery, under the direction of the Barker Funeral Home.
