

## Glenn O. McKeighan, 79

Glenn Oliver McKeighan, the son of William Oliver and Alva Grace (Mershon) McKeighan, was born Oct. 22, 1903, on a farm in Harrison Co. Glenn attended school in Tennant and grew to adulthood on the family farm.

On Oct. 29, 1922, Glenn was married to Alvina Marie Zacharias in Logan. Three children were born to this union. After marriage Mr McKeighan farmed and then worked for Cox Grain in Tennant and later worked for Omaha Steel Works. He also drove a bus for Davis Buslines until his retirement in 1965. After retiring Mr and Mrs McKeighan continued to live in Harlan, and became residents of the Baptist Memorial Home this past April.

Mr McKeighan was a member of the Immanuel Lutheran church in Harlan.

He died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on June 6, 1983 having attained the age of 79 years, 7 months and 8 days.

In addition to his parents Glenn was preceded in death by one son William "Rex"; and one grandson Glenn David McKeighan.

He is survived by his wife Alvina of Harlan; one daughter Phyllis (Mrs Orville) Andersen of Harlan; one son, Richard of Omaha, Neb.; 8 grandchildren and 7 great grandchildren; one sister, Maxine Tate of LaJunta, Colo.; nieces and nephews, other relatives and many friends.

Funeral services were held at the Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan on Wednesday,

June 8, 1983 with Pastors Kenneth P. Alpers, and Paul R. Olsen of the Immanuel Lutheran church in Harlan, officiating.

Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Verle Jones, Art Andersen, Gail Andersen, Darwin Warner, Larry Andersen and Raymond Andersen serving as casketbearers.
