



Frederic Namanny, 67

Frederic Namanny, son of Luke and Julia Jacobs Namanny, was born Jan. 8, 1915 at his parents' home northeast of Walnut and died Wednesday, Dec. 8, 1982 at Cass co. Memorial hospital in Atlantic, at the age of 67 years and 11 months.

He attended the local school. On July 3 at Omaha he married Thelma Pedersen of the Elk Horn area. They lived in Walnut and he was a trucker for his brother Earl Namanny in Marne and also worked independently. He was unable to drive the last four years because of his eyesight.

Surviving are his wife Thelma; two daughters, Mrs Norman (Shirley) Christensen of Elk Horn and Mrs Beverly Johansen of Omaha; two sons, Frederic (Bud) Namanny and Edward Namanny, both of Atlantic; eight grandchildren; a brother, Earl, of Walnut; two step-sisters and two step-brothers, all of Wisner, Neb. He was preceded in death by his parents; a sister, Myrtle McDermott and a brother Clarence.
