Muriel Marvel Nance, daughter of Henry W. and Edith Marvel Fisher, was born June 29, 1918 at Toluca, Ill. She died on Oct. 13, 1975, at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan at age 57 years, 3 months and 14 days. At the age of 2 she moved with her parents to Waynesville, Ill. She attended school and grew to adulthood in Waynesville. On Dec. 14, 1939 she married Donald E. Nance at Covington, Ind. To this union 2 children were born.
