MRS EDWARD V. NEWCOMB, 56

Marie Barbara Newcomb, daughter of Mathew and Barbara Engel Domino, was born Febr. 9, 1918 on a farm near Westphalia in Shelby county. She died at Myrtue Memorial hospital on April 18, 1974, at age 56 years, 2 months, 9 days. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Boniface church in Westphalia and she grew to adulthood in this community. She has been a member of St. Michael's church and St. Ann's Guild since moving to Harlan. On Febr. 4, 1941 she married Edward V. Newcomb at St. Boniface church in Westphalia. Four children were born to this union: Ronald of Harlan, Patricia (Mrs James Lombard) of Omaha, Nebr., Edwin of Harlan, and Jerald of Omaha. After their marriage they moved to Harlan and this has been her home since that time.

Mrs Newcomb was preceded in death by her husband, Ed, on Nov. 17, 1972 and by her parents. She is survived by her four children; six grandchildren; four brothers - Peter Domino of Harlan, Michael Domino of Norwalk, Ia., Ray Domino of Defiance, and Leo Domino of Des Moines; by two sisters - Margaret (Mrs Gerald Wilwerding) of Serria Madra, Calif., and Josephine (Mrs Linus Langenfeld) of Dow City; by her nieces and nephews and other relatives.

A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated at St. Michael's church in Harlan on Saturday, April 20, 1974 with Rev. Anthony J. Palmer as celebrant. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Dennis Domino, Gary Schwarte, Ronald Schaben, Gene Langenfeld, Norman Fletcher, and James Langenfeld serving as pallbearers.
