

Leona "Dutch" Newlin, 74

Leona Elfreida Newlin, daughter of Frederick and Augusta Jess Lilienthal, was born Aug. 9, 1907 on a farm north of Atlantic in Pymosa twp., Cass co. She attended school and in 1917, moved with her family to Atlantic. She graduated from the Atlantic high school in 1926, and then was employed at the office of Dr. Jone's hospital for a few years.

On April 19, 1930, she married Eugene F. Newlin in Atlantic. One son, Dennis and one daughter, Barbara, were born to this union. After their marriage, they made their home in Atlantic until 1946, when they moved to Harlan. In 1959, she was employed by Farner's Department Store in Harlan. After Mr Newlin died on Feb. 4, 1963, she continued to make her home in Harlan and work at Farner's, where she has been employed for the past 23 years.

She was a member of the First United Methodist church in Harlan. She was also a Charter Member of the Drove 23, BPO Does in Atlantic and the Eastern Star, Lebanon Chapter No. 8, O.E.S. of Harlan. She died at her home in Harlan on Tuesday, April 20, 1982, at the age of 74 years.

In addition to her husband and parents, she was preceded in death by two brothers, Frederick A. and Carl H. Lilienthal and two sisters, Mrs Emil Kluever and Mrs Rasmus Krogh. She is survived by her son, Dennis of Harlan and her daughter, Barbara (Mrs Gaige) Walters of Sarasota, Fla.; nine grandchildren; one sister, Hilda (Mrs Ray) Coker of Atlantic; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at the Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan on Friday.
