Nellie E. Newman, 88

Elk Horn — Nellie E. Newman, daughter of Matilda Peterson and August Newman was born April 8, 1892 in Essex. She died Monday, June 16, 1980, at Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn, at age 88 years, two months and eight days. Nellie attended the Essex high school. She worked at the Red Oak hospital for a number of years and kept house for her parents and later her brother. She moved to Harlan about 20 years ago and resided with her sister Lilly until entering the Salem Home in March of 1977.

She was baptized and confirmed at the St. John's Lutheran church in Essex and was a member of the Harlan Immanuel Lutheran church.

She was preceded in death by her parents, one brother - Walter and two sisters - Selma Newman, Laurine Rulon and Lilly Knox.
