The Life Story of— PEDER V. NIELSEN, 89

Peder Valdemar Nielsen was born Dec. 10, 1884 in Denmark and he grew to adulthood there. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith in Denmark. He came to the U.S. as a young man, coming to Shelby county where he worked as a farmhand and later farmed in this vicinity. In 1971 he became a resident at Mrs Mabel Monson's home in Irwin and he died there on April 11, 1974, just eight months before his 90th birthday.

He was preceded in death by his parents and all his brothers and sisters, most of whom lived in Denmark. Mr Nielsen is survived by his nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at the Pauley Home for Funerals in Harlan on Saturday, April 14, with Bro. Danny W. Cornish, pastor of the Harlan Church of Christ, officiating.
