## Juanita Nissen, 70

Juanita Jenevia Nissen was born April 30, 1911 in Walnut. She was one of five children born to John and Rose Hennings Jave.

She was baptized at home and confirmed in the Lutheran church in Walnut. She graduated from the Walnut high school. On Dec. 7, 1934 she married Melvin C Nissen. They farmed for nine years west of Elk Horn. In 1948 they moved to Elk Horn. Melvin died in 1953.

She continued Melvin's mail route for 14 years. She also worked at the Salem Nursing Home in Elk Horn. She lived in Harlan for a few years and then moved back to Elk Horn. She was a member of the Elk Horn Lutheran church. She has been a patient for sometime at the Clarkson hospital, Omaha, Neb., where she died Sunday, Sept. 13, 1981.

Survivors include one son: Terry of Co. Bluffs; one daughter: Rosemary (Mrs Darrell) Soe of Elk Horn; five grandchildren and two sisters; Loretta (Mrs Fred) Reich of Atlantic, and Irene Weddume of Ada, Okla. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, one sister: Ella Terkelsen; and one brother, John Jave Jr.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, Sept. 16, 1981 at the Elk Horn Lutheran church in Elk Horn with Pastor Eugene Soland officiating. Burial was in the Elk Horn Lutheran cemetery with Lanny Olson, Lee Nissen, Dave Jave, Dan Nissen, John Jave and Larry Jave serving as casketbearers.
