

THE LIFE STORY OF —

Ellinor E. Nyrup, 85

Ellinor Emma Nyrup, the daughter of John C. and Alga Almond Christoffersen, was born Aug. 4, 1899 at Chicago, Ill. She died in San Diego, Calif. on July 20, 1985, at age of 85 years, 11 months and 15 days.

Ellinor attended school in Ill., and later moved to Iowa at the age of 19. On Dec. 17, 1920, she married Enoch C. Nyrup at Harlan. One son, Elliott was born to this union.

After they were married, they lived and farmed in Shelby co., east of Harlan until 1949 when they moved into town. On July 24, 1967, Mr Nyrup died. She continued to live in Harlan after his death, until 1969, when she moved to Calif. to be closer to her son. This has been her home since that time. She was a member of the First Baptist church in Harlan.

She was preceded in death by her parents and husband. She is survived by one son, Elliott of San Diego, Calif.; one granddaughter, Susan; two sisters, Alice Jensen of Chicago, Ill.; and Rhoda Petersen of Pioneer, Calif; nieces, nephews and other relatives and friends.

Memorial Services were held Monday, Aug. 5, 1985, at the Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan with Pastor John Leggett, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery, Harlan.
