

Harry Petersen

ELK HORN — Harry Earnest Petersen, son of Peter A. and Mary Andersen Petersen was born Jan. 31, 1877, in Elk Horn. He married Agneta M. Hansen on June 3, 1927 in Elk Horn. He was a member of carpenters union 627 from 1940-77. Petersens farmed west of Elk Horn until Jan. 1940, when they moved to Dinsmore, Fla., where Harry did truck farming for a year. In 1941 he engaged in General and Industrial Carpentry until his retirement. In 1945 they purchased a home in Jacksonville, Fla. Harry died Jan. 10, 1977 at age 71 years, 11 months and 26 days after a lingering illness.

Survivors include his wife, a daughter - Ramona Petersen at home, a son - Duane Petersen of Jacksonville, Fla., three grandchildren, five sisters and three brothers. He was preceded in death by his parents.

Funeral services were held at Corey-Kerlin Funeral home in Jacksonville, Fla. Burial was in Reslawn Memorial Park.
