

LIFE STORY OF — **Anna Potter, 92**

Anna Marie Potter was one of ten children born to Thule and Maren Jensen. She was born on March 7, 1890 in Denmark. She came with the family to America at the age of 18 months. The family settled on a farm near Harlan, where she was reared and attended school. She was a member of the Baptist church in Harlan for many years. All of her brothers and sisters, as well as her parents, have preceded her in death. The brothers and sisters were: Martin Jensen, James Jensen, Carl Jensen, Peter Jensen, Chris Jensen, Jesse Jensen, Mary Frampton, a infant brother and an infant sister.

She married Clifford Potter on March 4, 1914 in Harlan. Two children were born to this union. They lived on a farm near Harlan until 1936 when they moved to Harlan. In 1954, they moved to Monrovia, Calif. She has been a member of the Baptist church in Monrovia since that time. They celebrated their 50th anniversary in 1964. Clifford died May 10, 1971.
