HARLAN — Alfred F. Rosman, 79, longtime Harlan area resident, died at his home here. The death was discovered Wednesday. — *March 23, 1977*

Funeral services will be at 10:30 a.m. Saturday at St. Michael's Catholic Church, with the Rev. Richard Wagner officiating and burial at St. Boniface Cemetery at Westphalia.

Rosman and a twin brother Alvin and sister Clara farmed at Glendale Farm north of Harlan from 1920 to 1970, when they retired to town.

Rosman held a third degree

in the Knights of Columbus No. 3900 of Harlan, and a fourth degree in Luke E. Hart Assembly of the Knights of Columbus of Defiance. He was also a member of the Defiance Challice Club and a 40-year member of the Shelby County Garden Club.

Before his brother Alvin's death in 1975, Rosman and he were members of both the Omaha Twin Club and International Twin Club and had won many trophies for being most identical.

The only survivor is a brother, Robert, of Kimballton.

Rosary will be at 8 p.m. this Thursday at the Pauley Funeral Home at Harlan, and a wake service will be conducted at 8 p.m. Friday at the funeral home.
