Schafer, daughter of John J. and Theresa Pimple Schafer, was born on a farm near Westphalia on Nov. 24, 1882. She was baptized in St. Boniface Catholic church at Westphalia and confirmed in St. Mary's Catholic church at Portsmouth. At the time of her death she had been a long time member of St. Mary's Catholic church at Panama. She attended St. Boniface school and grew to adulthood on her parent's farm. In 1920 she moved to Panama and this was her home until July of 1975. She then became a resident of the Westmont Care Center at Logan where she died on March 31, 1976, at age of 93 years, four months and seven days.
