

Henry Scheffler, 83

CORLEY — Henry Scheffler, son of Conrad and Caroline Brodenberg Scheffler was born in Streator, Ill., on April 15, 1894. He died at St. Joseph's Memorial Hospital in Omaha, Nebr., on May 26, 1977, at age 83 years, one month and 11 days. As a small boy, he moved with his parents to a farm south of Shelby. He attended country school and grew to adulthood on his parent's farm. Henry married Hilda Haas on June 21, 1913 in Co. Bluffs. To this union, six children were born. In June of this year, Mr and Mrs Scheffler would have been married for 64 years. After their marriage, Mr and Mrs Scheffler farmed in the Neola, Minden, Shelby and Corley areas. They retired from the farm in 1968 and moved to their present home in Corley. He was preceded in death by his parents; one son, Wayne Scheffler; two grandsons - Joseph Scheffler and Alan Overton; one great-grandson, Tyrone Scheffler, Jr.; five sisters - Minnie Baumann, Anna Stude, Kate Fixel, Lilly Ickes and Freida Haas; three brothers - William, Herman and Fred Scheffler. He is survived by his wife, Hilda Scheffler of Corley; one son, Omer Scheffler, of Harlan; four daughters - Iona (Mrs Melvin Lorenzen) of Beatrice, Nebr., Thelma (Mrs Boyd Dent) of Harlan, Yvonne (Mrs Victor Overton) of Co.
