## 1483 Austin J. Scheuring, 65

Austin Joseph Scheuring, the son of Joseph and Susan Mumm Scheuring, was born July 11, 1918, on farm near Defiance. He was baptized, received his First Communion and confirmed at St. Peter's Catholic church in Defiance. He attended St. Paul's school in Defiance and graduated in 1937, from St. Paul's high school. After school he farmed with his father.
