Mathilda Schoemann, 66

Wisconsin — Mathilda S. Schoemann, daughter of Nikolaus and Barbara Theisen Schoemann was born April 3, 1911 in Portsmouth. She died July 15, 1977 at University hospital in Madison, Wisc., at age 66 years. She attended Saint Mary's school in Panama and Ottumwa Heights College in Ottumwa, graduating in 1931. After spending several years teaching, she continued her education in the field of business and secretarial training at Rubicam Business School and Manpower Business Training Institute in St. Louis, Mo. Her most recent position was secretary to the Board of Education in the Public Schools of Madison.

Her parents and three sisters preceded her in death. Surviving are a brother, Chris Schoemann of Portsmouth, and a sister, Mrs Gertrude Kelly of Woodbine, an aunt, nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held in Sacred Heart church in Woodbine with Father Robert Schoemann, officiating. Burial was in St. Mary's cemetery in Panama with Eugene Schoemann, John Schoemann, Pat Kelly, Wayne Kelly, Kendall Kelly and Andrew Pauley serving as pallbearers.
