Dwayne Francis Schwarte, know to everyone as Dewey, the son of Joe and Helen Ratigan Schwarte, was born on July 2, 1942, on a farm near Defiance. He was baptized, received his First Communion and was confirmed at St. Peter's Catholic church in Defiance. He attended St. Peter's Catholic school in Defiance and graduated with the class of 1961. After graduating from school, he worked for Western Iowa Pork in Harlan, for a short time.

On May 21, 1964, he was enlisted into the U.S. Army, where he was stationed at Ft. Jackson, S.C. as a Private. After his Honorable Discharge on Nov. 18, 1964, he return-

ed to Defiance and continued work at Western Iowa Pork in Harlan.

On Oct. 28, 1972, he married Glenda Kloewer at St. Peter's Catholic church in Defiance. Two sons were born to this union. After their marriage, he continued to work for Western Iowa Pork until 1975. Then he worked for the Denison Hide Co. in Denison, for a short time, before he returned to Western Iowa Pork Later he began working at Farmland Foods in Denison, until Aug. of 1983. They then continued to live in Defiance.

He was a member of St. Peter's Catholic church in Defiance. He died at his home

in Defiance on April 10, 198 at the age of 41 years, 9 months and 8 days.
