Harold, son of William and Melanie Schoening Schwieso, was born March 15, 1913, near Manilla, in Crawford.co. He attended rural schools near his home.

He served in the U.S. Navy from Aug., 1942, until his honorable discharge in Nov., 1945. He served all three years aboard the USS Independence in the South Pacific. After returning from the service, he farmed until his retirement in 1969. He moved into Manilla and worked for Gruhn Hybrids and cared for the Nishnabotna cemetery in the summers.

He was a member of Trinity Lutheran church and the American Legion Post No. 132, Manilla. He died Friday, Feb. 25, 1983, at Veterans Hospital, Omaha, at the age of
