

Mrs Herbert A. Sellman, 89

Sioux City — Mrs Herbert A. Sellman of Sioux City died Wednesday, March 14, 1979 at St. Joseph's hospital after a lengthy illness at age 89 years.

Mrs Sellman, the former Flora Mae Hoskins, was born April 5, 1889 in Correctionville. She married Herbert A. Sellman on June 12, 1907 in Correctionville. They farmed at Correctionville until 1926 when they moved to Battle Creek, to start an auto repair shop. They moved to Sioux City in 1948 upon retirement.
